- Coverage is between 300 to 600 square feet per gallon, per coat, depending on the type of surface and porosity.

STORAGE & HANDLING:

DIRECTIONS FOR USE AND SURFACE PREPARATION:

- Apply on steel, slate, aluminum, wood, galvanized and other non-porus surfaces.
- Use as a rust inhibitive primer.
- Use over spalled reinforced concrete where re-bar is showing.
- Prevents sap staining of unprimed wood, and water stains in ceiling panels.
- Markedly reduces corrosion of ferrous metal and enhances adhesion of topcoats over chalky surfaces.

SURFACE PREPARATION

- Surface to be painted must be clean and dry.
- Remove all dirt, excess chalky residue, oils, grease, mildew or other surface contaminants.
- Make sure surface is completely dry before application.

APPLICATION:

- Use brush, roller or spray to apply.
- Do not apply at temperatures below 50° F or when rain, darkness or cold are imminent.
